

Course in Ethics and Governance



- understand the relationship between ethics and governance
- have an overview of how to manage organisational ethics
- be equipped to compile an organisational ethics risk profile and determine positive and negative ethics risk
- have an overview of ethics codes and policies
- be able to implement and manage ethics management strategies, ethics training and monitor ethics performance
- be competent in reporting the ethics performance of an organisation in terms of both internal and external ethics reporting

Learning Methods

The course is practice-based and practitioner-led. This involves discussions and drawing on experiences of the participants. The course will involve understanding the requirements of good governance, identifying problems and providing workable solutions which will lead to the overall success of the organisation. The assessment will include case studies, role playing etc.

Target Audience

The programme is designed for all sectors, including private organisations, non-profitable organisations and public entities. It is also designed for managers and senior planners, personnel responsible for ethics and governance of the organisation.

Description

There is no denying that business worldwide faces ethical issues and dilemmas, and ethics have become very important to ensure sustainability and a corporate future especially in South Africa. This course will introduce participants to an efficient ethics management framework as well as cover core concepts related to organisational ethics. This will enable delegates to plan and implement an ethics and good governance programme.

Outcomes

On completion of the course, the participants will be able to :

- understand the definitions of and distinctions in organisational ethics and the importance of organisational ethics in the government environment
