

Course in Risk Management



Description

The course is aimed at providing participants with the ability to understand the concept and principles of risk as well as the benefits and limitations of risk management. The course will enable participants to identify risks and create an action plan to control these risks within their own organisation. Participants will explore common incidences of fraud and corruption in organisation.

This programme will provide a broad introduction to the subject of risk management and broaden their knowledge. Risk Management is a practice with processes, methods and tools for managing risks in a project. It provides the skills to use, maintain, and extend the functionality of a Risk Management system by effectively analysing and producing firm-wide risk management tools and measures.

Outcomes

On completion of the course, the participants will be able to :

- explain the importance, principles and basic concepts of risk management to their work
- apply techniques to identify, assess, quantify and control potential risks
- develop at departmental and organisation level the “Top 10 Risk list”
- develop risks mitigation strategies in a work context
- control risks through planning, monitoring, controlling and acting
- describe the characteristics of a risk entrepreneur
- evaluate the risk of fraud and corruption in the workplace

Learning Methods

The course is learner centered. It is practice-based and will involve discussions drawing on experiences of the participants. The course will involve identification of risks, completion of risk registers and integration of theory with practice to find solutions on handling of risks.

Target Audience

The programme is designed for all sectors, including private organisations, non-profitable organisations and public entities. Anyone involved with identifying, reporting, evaluating or managing an exposure to risk will be in need of risk management training. Junior, middle or senior managers, decision-makers and professionals who are responsible for some aspect of the organisations overall risk management effort should attend.

Duration

The course is delivered over 2 consecutive days.

Fees

The cost of the course is available on request. Corporate discounts are available for 5 or more participants from the same organisation. Fees will include tuition, learning materials, meal and refreshments.
