

Course in Supply Chain Management



Description

This course will introduce participants to the importance of supply chain management. The course focuses on the theoretical side of supply chain management and gives the participant a detail understanding of how it contributes to the success of the business. It focuses on the interactive tasks and activities which will aim at imparting knowledge through the process of learning-by- doing.

Outcomes

On completion of the course, the participants will be able to :

- explain the basic principles of Supply chain management, its purpose, criteria and how it effectively can be put into action
- understand the Supply chain management cycle and how it is implemented

- identify and utilize different Supply Chain measurement tools recognizing the advantages and disadvantages of each
- execute and evaluate a successful Supply Chain management feedback session
- identify and resolve the problems that may arise through the Supply chain management process i.e.lack of training, corruption etc
- be able to manage the overall performance of the employees and the success of the organisation

Learning Methods

The course is practice-based and practitioner lead. This involves discussions and drawing on experiences of the participants. The course will involve understanding supply chain management, identifying problems and providing workable solutions which will lead to the overall success of the organisation.

Target Audience

The programme is designed for all sectors, including private organisations, non-profitable organisations and public entities. It is also designed for managers and senior planners, personnel responsible for supply chain management, demand management, production planning, purchase planning or stock control should attend.

This course is also designed for individuals concerned with improving the overall success of their organisation, better managing their subordinates, employees or team members and getting the best results.

The course is delivered over 2 consecutive days.
