



2026 International Study Tour Turkey: Istanbul

Payments need to be made in full by 31 March 2026


Includes:

Tour & travel Expectations

We kindly request your cooperation in adhering to the following guidelines.

01. Accommodation

Accommodation will be provided at a hotel that has a variety of amenities including wifi access. All rooms are single occupancy.

02. Meals

Breakfast is provided at the hotel.

03. Airfare

Durban / Johannesburg to Turkey, Istanbul

04. Attendance & Attire

Participants are required to attend all planned activities. Formal dress will be required for all official visits.

05. Free Time

Free time is scheduled during the study tour. Group activities may be organised during this time, but participation is completely optional.

06. Luggage

Luggage is limited to one carry-on not exceeding 7kgs and one checked-in suitcase not exceeding 23kgs. Please keep in mind that you are your own porter for the duration of the trip.

07. Vaccination, Medical and Travel Insurance

Where applicable, participants are responsible for obtaining a vaccination card and are liable to cover the cost of the vaccines. Participants are liable to cover their own medical and travel insurance costs.

08. VISA

All participants will need a valid Turkey visa.
